## Wheel Hub Bearing Locknut Wrench



An old socket (ID larger than the sliding top hat spacer) with most of the teeth hogged. Cut some slots and made some little ears. <sup>1)</sup>



Cut a stepped bar in the lathe to fit the bearings. The big end got pressed into the socket. The step sits  $3/16''$  below the business end of the socket. <sup>2)</sup>



Held it together with a hose clamp for welding. <sup>3)</sup>
