General

This Police Service Bulletin is being issued to inform Harley-Davidson dealers about a Headlight On/Off Switch Kit for 1991 and later FXRP police motorcycles. This kit will allow the motorcycle operator to turn off the headlight and front running lamps for special service requirements by using a thumb switch on the left handlebar control.

WARNING

- Many local and state statutes require daytime use of headlights to make motorcycles more conspicuous. Any modification to a motorcycle lighting system, for the purpose of overcoming the automatic headlight-on feature, could increase the operator's risk of personal injury.
- This kit is intended for installation and use on law enforcement motorcycles only.
 - Do not install this kit on any police vehicle unless this option is specifically required by the department.
 - Do not sell this kit to the general public.
 - Do not install this kit on privately-owned civilian motorcycles under any circumstances.

Parts Orders

The Headlight On/Off Switch Kit (Part No. 91270-92) may be ordered only through the Manager of Police Motorcycle Sales at Harley-Davidson, Inc. A copy of the departmental formal request (or departmental specification statement covering this option) and a copy of the dealer order (including the vehicle identification number) must be sent to Harley-Davidson, Inc. before the order can be processed.

Installation

The kit should be installed in its entirety; this includes all warning decals. An indicator lamp is supplied with the kit, and must be installed in the fuel tank console. This lamp will illuminate when the headlight and front running lamps are off.

Resale of Kit-Modified Vehicles

Ultimately, when any kit-modified motorcycle is to be resold, the Headlight On/Off Switch Kit **must** be removed from the vehicle prior to the vehicle sale; the selling law enforcement agency is responsible for the kit removal. It is recommended that the vehicle be taken to an authorized Harley-Davidson dealer for the required removal service.
