

NEW STARTER MOTOR FOR ELECTRA GLIDE AND SERVI-CAR

Beginning in February 1966, Prestolite starter motors are being used as original equipment on the Electra Glide model in place of Delco-Remy starter motors. As soon as present stock of Delco-Remy starter motors are used up, this same starter motor will also be used on the Servi-Car model. Delco-Remy motors will no longer be available at that time.

For parts order, the Prestolite starter motor, part No. 31455-64A will be supplied with extra support brackets and hardware to fit all earlier models using Delco-Remy starter motors. Motor components and parts list are shown in illustration.



Note:

When installed on 1965 to early 1966 Servi-Cars which used the Delco-Remy starter motor, the starter motor mounting pad on the transmission must be drilled and tapped with 2 extra holes according to instructions included with starter motor. These extra holes are already in the mounting flange on late 1966 Servi-Cars and do not have to be drilled.
