GAS LINE FILTER AND HOSES CHANGED - ELECTRA GLIDE

The gas line filter used on Electra Glides equipped with Tillotsen Model HD carburetor has been changed from AC number GF-61 to AC number GF-94, starting with motorcycle engine Serial No. 66FL8809. The new filter has a 40 micron filter element -this was a 10 micron element previously. All replacement filters now supplied from the factory under Part No. 62350-66 are of the new type which will give an extended service life without restricting the fuel supply.

The gas and vent line hoses on all future motorcycle shipments will be fabric reinforced rubber material which is resistant to ozone cracking. The outside diameter of the new hose is larger requiring new clamps for making connections to fittings. Three band type clamps are used at vent line T-connection and one band type clamp at carburetor gas inlet connection. Wire type clamps are used for the other connections.

Vent line T-connection is now located directly behind instrument panel mounting bracket, and vent hose is routed directly downward in space between tanks and along frame tube to carburetor connection. All replacement hoses now supplied from the factory are of the new type and have new part numbers as shown below.

RECOMMENDATION:

Replace all Part No. 62350-66 filters marked GF-61 with new GF-94 filters at the next motorcycle preventive maintenance period, or immediately if faulty carburetion is indicated. Also replace old type solid rubber gas and vent line hoses with new fabric reinforced hoses and new hose clamps.
