ELECTRIC STARTER RELAY CONVERSION KIT FOR 1965 TO LATE 1967 ELECTRA GLIDES

Production Electra Glides, beginning February 13, 1967, incorporate a relay in the starter control circuit to provide battery current directly from the regulator BAT. terminal to the starter solenoid coil; the handlebar starter button is connected to the relay. This arrangement provides more positive pull-in of the starter pinion gear and solenoid main contacts under a low battery condition, and, in general provides more dependable starting.

The starter relay with installing instructions, necessary hardware and wiring, is available from the factory in kit form under Part No. 71451-65. List price is \$6.30. Relay is mounted to a bracket on bottom of battery carrier on right side of motorcycle.

The relay kit is recommended for use on early Electra Glides, especially on motorcycles where starting circuit trouble has been experienced in the past.
