XL GEARCASE COVERS AND GASKETS

Late 1981 and early 1982 engines may have one of two different types of gear case cover and crankcase set combinations.

The following illustrations identify differences between late and early style components. Refer to the chart to determine which components can be intermixed.

CAUTION

Improperly intermixing components can cause loss of topend oil pressure and subsequent damage. After replacing any of these components, check top-end oil circulation to ensure proper operation.

Early Style Cover	Yes—use with early style gasket	Yes—use with early style gasket
Late Style Cover	Cannot be used	Yes—use with late style gasket

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


Figure 1. Gearcase Components
