## 2006 VRSCR INITIAL CARE PROGRAM

### General

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide information on the Initial care Program for 2006 VRSCR Model Year motorcycles.

As part of the introduction of the 2006 VRSCR, Technical Service is providing the VRSCR Initial Care Program. Key components in the program are:

- **VRSCR Initial Care Phone Line (414) 343-8357:** allows direct access for technical support and warranty pre-approval decisions.
- Minimal parts protected, allowing dealers to stock an inventory of repair parts.
- Warranty Pre-Authorization from VRSCR Technical Service is required for specific components in Table 1. This allows Harley-Davidson to monitor initial repair trends on significant components.
- Emergency weekend or holiday repairs can be completed by the dealer **only if customer satisfaction is at stake**, but will still require contacting VRSCR Initial Care on the following weekday for review and authorization.
- The VRSCR Initial Care Program has an intended life span of **Product Launch through August-1-2005**. It will be reviewed at that time and extended if necessary.
