Additional Parts Required

Installation of rear disc kit (44421-09 & 41500066) on FXSTD 17-inch wheels requires separate purchase of brake rotor hub plate (43837-00).

NOTE

This instruction sheet references service manual information. A service manual for your model motorcycle is required for this installation and is available from a Harley-Davidson Dealer.

Kit Contents

INSTALLATION

NOTE

The floating disc screw holes are countersunk to accept the retaining screw heads. Be sure to install the screws properly.

1. See the service manual for rotor removal, assembly and disassembly procedures.
2. Assemble the brake disc pads as described in the service manual.

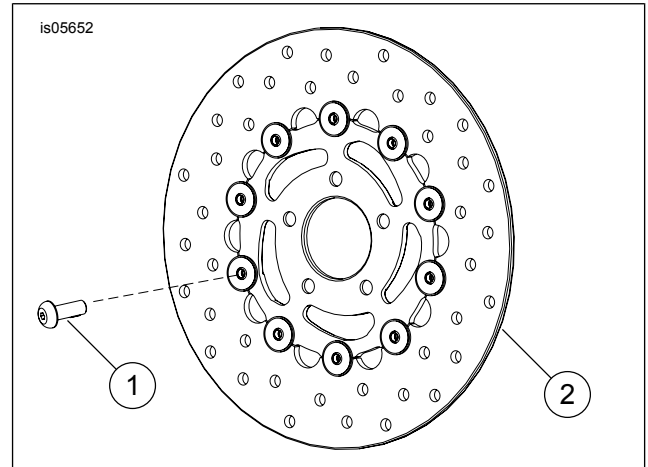


Figure 1. Service Parts: Reaper Floating Rotor Kits

3. See Figure 1. Install the new screws (1).
4. Tighten rear disc screws to 40.7–61 N·m (30–45 ft-lbs).

NOTE

Avoid hard stops for the first 100 miles. Hard stops during the wear-in period will gall discs.

5. Tighten front disc screws to 21.6–32.5 N·m (16–24 ft-lbs).
